The Sub-Commission is invited to hold a preliminary discussion on the draft study on Children's rights in Constitutions, to be drawn up on the basis of the report by Ms Ursula Kilkelly and Mr Conor O'Mahony.

3. Opinion on the draft law on Protection from Defamation of Azerbaijan

The Sub Commission is invited to discuss the draft opinion (CDL(2013)041) on the draft law on Protection from Defamation of Azerbaijan (CDL-REF(2013)022rev), drawn up on the basis of comments by Mr Clayton, Mr van Dijk, Ms Palma and Ms Thorgeirsdottir as well as Mr Millar (Consultant, Media Department, Information Society and Action against Crime Directorate), with a view to its adoption at the Plenary Session.
