7. Opinions and studies of the Venice Commission

Participants will be informed about opinions and reports on constitutional justice and the ordinary judiciary, adopted by the Venice Commission since the last meeting of the JCCJ in April 2023.

8. Co-operation activities

 Participants will be informed about the Venice Commission's co-operation with the Association of Asian Constitutional Courts and Equivalent Institutions (AACC) and other WCCJ regional and linguistic groups.

9. World Conference on Constitutional Justice (WCCJ)

Since the WCCJ's Statute entered into force on 24 September 2011, 120 Constitutional Courts, Constitutional Councils and Supreme Courts exercising constitutional justice have acceded to the WCCJ. The updated list of members is available at: www.venice.coe.int/WCCJ.

In October 2025, the WCCJ will hold its 6th Congress in Madrid, Spain, on the topic "Human Rights for future Generations". The Secretariat will inform liaison officers of the state of preparation of the 6th Congress.
